1. Week 20 – Three days only. Driver No 7 now fully operational. DBS Clearance for SH received. Credit card timetable forwarded to printers.

**2. Week 19** – Tuesday - Fuel still leaking from engine for first two minutes after start up. Bus booked in for further repair on Saturday Feb 20<sup>th</sup> 2016. On Friday Feb 19<sup>th</sup> at 2.30pm brakes failed owing to sudden loss of brake fluid. Bus recovered to RCC contract garage by breakdown crew from Melton. Concern expressed about quality of workmanship on vehicle. Bus still off road on 23.32.16! RCC asked to advise return date asap due to repeated enquiries from public. DBS Clearance for Jim Gray now received. Despite only running for four days week has highest number of passenger journeys yet!

**3. Week 18** - Bus leaking diesel from engine. Taken to garage Saturday 12.2.16 - Bus in for RCC inspection on Mon 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2016

4. Week 17 - Bus in for repair two days with faulty step.

5. Week 17 - Phil Whay now Driver A on rota!

6. Week 17 - Steve Harvey training to commence in Week 18. Week 16 lost property owner now identified.

7. Week 16 - Driver team meeting held at 5.15pm on Friday Jan 29<sup>th</sup> 2016 in The Falcon Hotel. Two new drivers introduced to team. Joint discussion held on future of project and possible extension of volunteering roles. Lost property (handbag) handed in to police via Town Clerk

8. Week 16 – Bus taken out of service at 12.30pm on Friday Jan 29<sup>th</sup> 2016 following breakdown of electric step. Possible leaking fuel tank also reported to RCC and garage.

9. Week 15 - 1.5 days lost waiting for bus repair. DOT guideline inspection carried out. Bus returned with brakes sorted and new /remould tyres, presumably authorised by RCC.

10. Week 15 - Bus taken out of service 4.30pm on 21.1.15 to repair front left tyre puncture, balance and correctly inflate two front tyres to 70 psi. Fault on inner wall of replacement tyre noted and reported to RCC.

11. Week 15 - Driver Phil Whay commissioned and supported on first half day shift by RS.

12. Week 14 - Bus taken out of service and returned to garage for brake part replacement and tyre inspection 2.30pm Jan 15<sup>th</sup> 2016.

13. Week 14 - DBS clearance waited from RCC on two additional drivers. Sally Killips is chasing up! Query about missing D1 Cat on volunteer JG licence taken up.
