The Uppingham Hopper Trial Extension - July 1st 2016 - September 30th 2016

1. Introduction

This brief report is prepared for Uppingham Town Council (UTC). Its purpose is to propose a final financial contribution to the Uppingham Hopper pilot, extending the trial period up to September 30th 2016, thereby facilitating further study of the Hopper's long term viability, social benefit and value for money over a whole year. The report should be read in conjunction with earlier interim reports.

A report exploring the possibility of creating a 'not for profit' Uppingham tourism and transport entity that might offer a permanent Hopper service for the future will be presented to the September Board meeting of Uppingham First. UTC will be consulted about this separately.

2. Statistics Todate

The Hopper trial has now exceeded 5000 passenger journeys. Weekly figures are below. From Week 32, as requested by RCC, voluntary donations toward the cost of establishing a permanent service have been collected. Current total of collections is £570.48. This excludes the sum raised from the community and local businesses by former Town Mayor Cllr David Ainslie at his Mayor's Bus mileage todate has exceeded 500 kilometres per week. As the bus is aging rapidly(mechanically), RCC has agreed to loan a school bus for five weeks of the proposed final trial period but has also indicated it is unable to contribute toward the ongoing operator costs.


3. Cost of Final Phase of Trial

The bus fuel bill averages around £ 450.00 per month and insurance for a final three month period has cost £221.97, a very competitive price from Zurich Insurance. Total cost of the final stage of the trial, including bus cleaning and testing costs, is therefore estimated to be around £1700.

4. Proposal

UTC is invited to consider a final grant for the Uppingham Hopper trial of £1000 to ensure its operation until September 30^{th} 2016.
