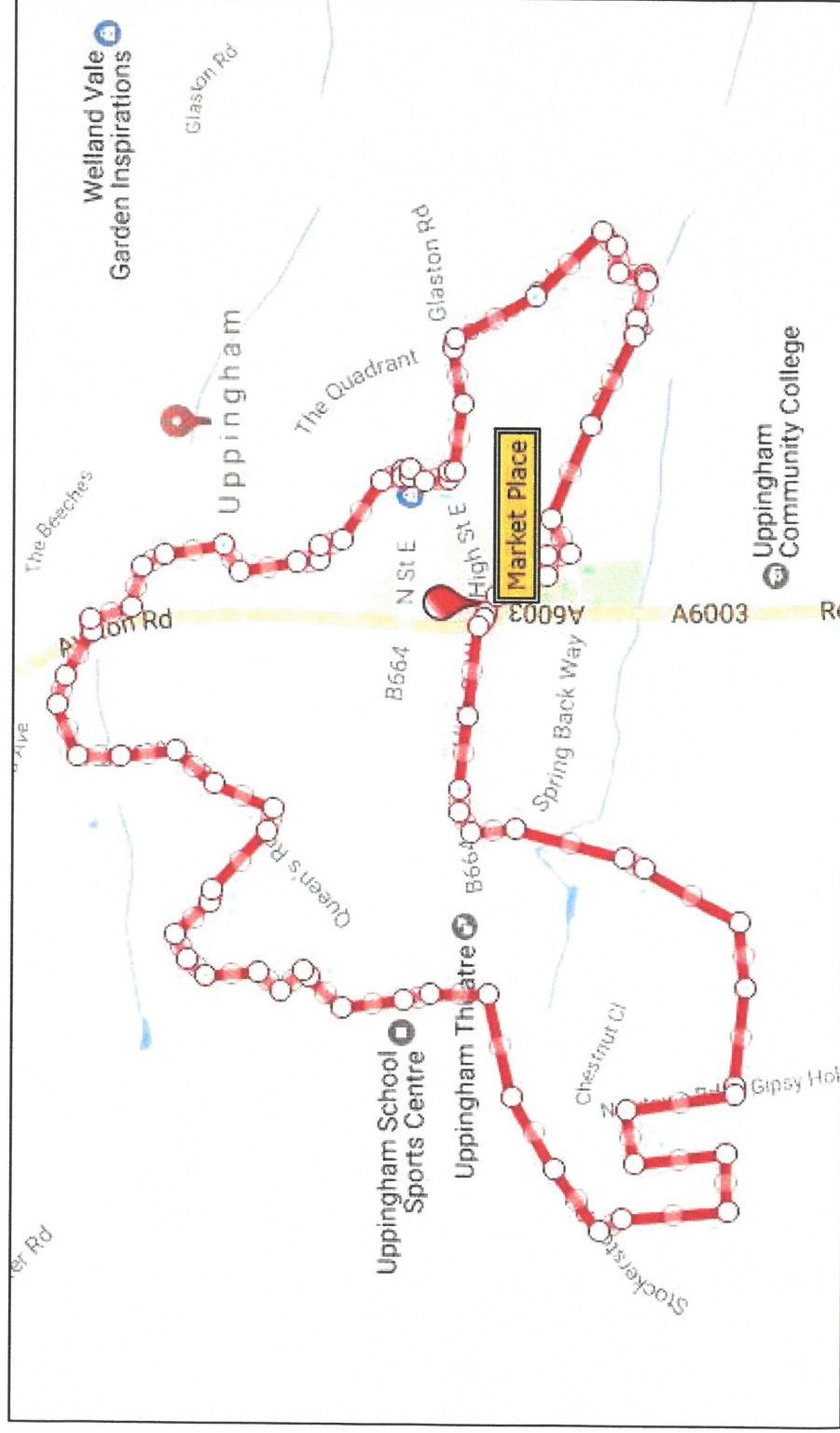


Mayor's Walk – Sunday 25th June 2017 at 10:30am meet in the Market Place

Route Guide for the Mayor's Walk – 25th June 2017

Departs Market Place, Uppingham Place at 10:30am

- Cross A6003 at controlled crossing at the top of London Road and head along High Street West (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Turn left at the top of High Street West on to Spring Back Way turning right on to the cinder path
- Continue on to the Middle heading for the small timber cricket pavilion turn right and following the hedge
- Join the footpath running alongside Leighfield School to Newtown Road and turn right
- Head along Newtown Road turning left through the pedestrian alley to join Stockerston Crescent
- Turn left and walk around Stockerston Crescent to the junction with Stockerston Road and turn right (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Proceed along Stockerston Road turning left into the Western Quad of Uppingham School by the new Science Block
- Proceed through the Quad and in front of the Uppingham School Sports Centre and on to Leicester Road (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Cross the Leicester Road and walk along Lime Tree Avenue turning right into Oak Close
- Proceed across the grass to Belgrave Road alongside Uppingham C of E School to Branston Road
- Continue along Branston Road until the last bend to the left and cut through across the open space to Ayston Road (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Use the automated pedestrian crossing to head on to the lay by on Ayston Road by The Beeches before heading up Wheatley Avenue to the Tod's Terrace footpath.
- On joining Tod's Piece use the path by the skate park to head across the football pitch to North Street East by Gainsborough Road junction. (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Cross at the zebra crossing and enter the car park for the Town Hall to cut through to High Street East
- Turn left on High Street East to the roundabout and then right on to Seaton Road before heading into Ash Close
- Turn left on Ash Close and join the footpath that leads on to Station Road
- Head up Station Road past Arnold Wills & Co on to South View before turning right up the steps on Beast Hill (**Marshall Supervised Crossing**)
- Proceed around the back of the Church and Church Rooms before emerging into the Market Place

Please bring cameras and phones so that any issues concerning the state of paths, vegetation and litter can be captured on the way. It is anticipated the walk will last about 75 minutes and will finish just ahead of The Annual Feast Day opening in the Market Place.
