AYSTON ROAD (A6003)

PARISH OF UPPINGHAM CP ORDER 2017

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary One-Way Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) A6003 Ayston Road Parish of Uppingham CP Order 2017, as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding in a Southbound direction along the length of road known as A6003 Ayston Road from the A6003 roundabout to Firs Avenue.

The One-Way closure, is to enable kerbing works to take place on the carriageway. The works are being undertaken by Tarmac, on behalf of Rutland County Council.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 22nd January 2018 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 33 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 22nd January 2018 until 23rd February 2018

The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan (also available to view at the Council Office) and/or as shown on roadworks.org

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: Take the A47 towards Glaston; at roundabout take 3rd exit to A43, A427 (Weldon), Westcott Way (A427) and Uppingham Road (A6003) with a reciprocal route.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises whilst the work is being carried out.
