Following the positive comments from both the stall holders and the general public that attended the Show in August 2017. The Committee once again would like to hold the U.F.F.P.S. on Tod's Piece.

Overall feed- back from last year's Show, was the U.F.F.P.S. was more accessible to residents in Uppingham, was a welcome use of Tod's Piece and made use of the adjoining facilities of both the Towns Football Club and Scout Hut.

The U.F. F.P.S. 2018 will once again include the Traditional Produce Tent as in previous years, where residents from both Uppingham and the surrounding villages are encouraged to showcase their gardening, baking and artistic abilities.

All in the spirit of friendly competition.

The U.F.F.P.S will provide a variety of trade stands for local charities, local traders and businesses, traditional crafts, children's entertainment, visit from the Rare Bread Farm in Oakham for petting of llamas and goats as well as the Fun Dog Show.

For the younger members of the community there will be a funfair, face painting and interactive involvement. In addition there will be live music, featuring local artists, Radio Rutland will be streaming the Show live throughout the afternoon. A variety of refreshments will be available, using a local caterer and local food, together with various other attractions.

The aim of the event is to bring the various communities within Uppingham and the surrounding villages in Rutland together.

By providing a wide range of attractions, we hope to bring the town together, increasing community spirit.

The U.F.F.P.S. is aimed at the whole community, with attractions to cater for all age groups. There will be Free attractions, to make the day an enjoyable event for all.

The U.F.F.P.S. offers a unique opportunity to bring together those from different ethnic and age groups to share the interests of others and to showcase the talents of the residents in and around the Uppingham area.

Chairpersons report for 2017 by Nicola Jervis

Uppingham Fete, Flower and Produce Show held on August 6th 2017.

The show was another success with approximately over 1,500 people visiting the show even though there had been changeable weather to the run up to the show and on the day started off with sunshine which the changed to cloud.

Publicity was carried out through Rutland Radio, Banners on the Uppingham town boundaries and also each dwelling in Uppingham had a schedule delivered 3 week before the show. There were also several shops and establishment that willingly displayed the schedules and were topped up regularly as necessary. Posters were displayed when the banners were being erected also.

It is to be noted that when applying for the grant through the Uppingham Town County Council that there are now only two months when grants are discussed which is November and May. They have also asked that included information about Child Protection Policy or how we manage safeguarding within the show. Grant information to be shared at the next meeting for planning of the show for 2018. Risk assessment is also to mention members of the Committee who are currently DBS screened within their job roles, also will investigate if we can apply to all get volunteer DBS done through on what was a 99 form which I am lead to believe should not cost us very much.

We have continued to work in partnership with the Uppingham Town County Council and Uppingham Town Football Club. The 21 local businesses have donated prize for the Grand Prize Draw with some also being involved with advertising. Thank you to Graham for sorting out the new schedule layout and advertisements. The new poster's which were designed by Rutland Creative where a breath of fresh air and should be adapted to the schedule but leaving the events of the day off as these do change.

Thank you to Emily for working with the Uppingham Vets Practice for prizes for all the dogs who entered the dog show and also Chloe who with Emily changed some of the classes of the dog show making them more fun. Thorpe by Water again sponsored the Rosettes this year colours were 1st orange, 2nd purple, 3rd green, with the Best in Show being red. Emily and Chloe you did a brilliant job together and the ring sides were full. Uppingham vets continue to support us with Judges for the day.

In the show tent area thank you Karen for your long distant support and also on the run up to the show organisation of entrees, along with Annie and Sarah on the Saturday evening at Don Paddies. On the day the quick erecting of tables soon saw the show tent in action and ready to receive all entries from exhibitor registered and some late registration by Karen and Annie. I am informed that there was an increase in exhibitors but that Karen's report.

For the entertainment Rob Persani was certainly more on the ball with his prompt guidance from the committee, The Jason Chandler Jazz Quartet was certainly different to our previous performers and at regular intervals swapped with Rob Persani giving an even balance of entertainment playing at the right level.
