Part 2 - What is your idea and reason for applying for grant aid funds from Uppingham Town Council?

The idea is 'Uppin'nam Smiling -Ten Years On' a 'follow-up' to the successful 'Uppingham Smiling 2008' Exhibition.

The amended date for this EVENT is now END September/ early October 2018 owing to revisions in the last 24 hours by a major/significant exhibitor.

The 2008 exhibition was attended by aprox. 500 people in February 2008

(U.T.C. Neil Wedge Town Clerk was given the D.V.D 'Uppingham Smiling 2008' of that Exhibition attended by residents & ex-residents from as far afield as the USA & Russia. aged between 12months (James Hackney's baby)—94 years('Nic' from 'Smalls' auntie)

That original exhibition was influenced by a range of observations not only just of 'Art' but by both the local primary school children & the Senior citizens.

Much from Little neighbourhood group(founded 2009)was a result of that initial even & has continued 'creative activities' with harpists; sculpture; furniture plus parents & childrens holiday activities on the High Street(empty shop)as well as celebrations/activities on Branston Road(latest of which is the 12 metres long 'Rainbow' on the garden wall of 'Pickles End')

The group has had to find most of the funding for these activities from 'out of it's own pockets' however & because of such increases in Public Liability Insurance - a different venue that doesn't require moving all the church chairs 7 times throughout a 10 day period; the hire of a suitable marquee located within the neighbourhood would facilitate & further enhance this corner of Uppingham.

'Cradle to Grave' – the local young people/adults & families from preparation; participation (over these past 10 years) seeing the results of their labours to improve this area of Uppingham (often known as 'The Flats')

Morale boosting; 'Well-being' – A Sense of Achievement both locally & those visiting friends from both this country & abroad.

All(15) the Large 6' x 4' Photo/painting plastic Laminates will be donated to Uppingham Town Council

(for historical records/purposes – visual archives of the Townspeople of Uppingham)

By the actual co-ordination & implementation of all the aspects of 'mounting' such a venture(achievement in itself) furthermore plenty of advanced publicity(flyers local; media)& the evidence gather at the first 'Uppingham Smiling' – with most of the original exhibits will be on display.

The yardstick for success must be that 'feelgood factor' which has already been the outcome & the creation of these exhibits over these past Ten Years. Influences going as far afield as India Ukraine Russia & the USA.

'Much from Little' a not for profit org. 'The Purpose of Education is to Enable Everyone to have a Purpose' - 'from Cradle to Grave'.

The title was influenced by the Rutland County motto - 'Much in Little'.

We, a group of 'Incomers to Branston Road, Uppingham during that Long Hot Summer of 1976 - one of whom was trying to dig a 'garden' in a dressing gown on a Sunday afternoon, discovered they had an empathy with this idiosyncratic behaviour & soon became good creative neighbours. These neighbours, in addition to their 'day-time' jobs, eventually became 'working colleagues' with both the Local Youth Service & the 'special needs' Adult Gateway club provision. We also discovered the variety of mutual 'creative' interests that were based on both our formal and informal educational activities. Individually we found that access to financial support was almost impossible thus recognizing the benefits of 'formalization' we became 'a not for profit organization' - through the encouragement of Voluntary Action Rutland.
