## **PARISH OF UPPINGHAM CP ORDER 2018**

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Spring Back Way Parish of Uppingham CP Order 2018, as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as Spring Back Way, from its junction with Stockerston Road to London Road.

The Closure is to enable Tarmac, to undertake footway resurfacing on behalf of Rutland County Council.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 23rd July 2018 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 3 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

## The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: From 23rd July 2018 until 25th July 2018


The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan (also available to view at the Council Office) and/or as shown on roadworks.org

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: London Road, Orange Street, North Street West, Leicester Road and Stockerston Road.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises whilst the work is being carried out.
