(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)

Morcott Road A47

Parish of Glaston CP Order 2023

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Morcott Road Parish of Glaston CP Order 2022 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as Morcott Road A47 from Glaston to B672 junction at Morcott to allow relining to take place.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 27th November 2023 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 3 nights. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 27th November 2023 to 30th November 2023 between 20:30 and 06:00 each day.

The alternative route during the closure will be via the route shown on the attached plan and as shown on https://one.network

The alternative route during the closure will be via the following streets: Glaston Road, Stamford Road, Barrowden Road, Peterborough Road, Leicester Road, A43 Stamford Road, Old Dry Lane, Bangrave Road, Steel Road, Phoenix Park Way, Gretton Brook Road, Rockingham Road, Uppingham Road, Main Street, Caldecott Road, The Turnpike, London Road, Orange Street, Ayston Road, Uppingham Roundabout, Duddington Way and Main Road with a reciprocal route.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
